Participant's Outline "Part 2"

I. Meeting 1: The Criteria for Marriage.

In this first meeting you will cover chapters one and two of "Preparing for Your Marriage

II. Meeting 2: Christian Marriage I – Basics.

This second meeting will cover chapters 3-11 in "Preparing For Your Marriage."

A. **The basics of marriage.** A thorough study of Genesis 2:18-24.

1. Adam did not take a wife; he received one from God!

2. Marriage is permanent! Leviticus 21:7,14, Deuteronomy 22:19, 24:1-3, Jeremiah 3:1,8, Ezekiel 44:22; Malachi 2:16, Matthew 5:31-32; 19:3-12; Mark 10:2-12; Luke 16:18, Romans 7:1-3.)

3. Genesis 2:18: *Then the Lord God said, "It is not good for the man to be alone; I will make him a helper suitable for him."*

4. The tests of love from I Corinthians 13:4-7. To what extent do these qualities of love exist in your relationship? Which are less evident?

III. Meeting 3: Christian Marriage II – A Christian husband, A Christian wife.

This meeting will cover chapters 12-17 in "Preparing for Your Marriage."

The outline for the men should include the following.

A. Biblical headship and leadership. The main Scripture references will come from Ephesians 5.

B. How is the husband to love his wife as Christ loved the Church? Verses from Ephesians 5 and Colossians 3 should be emphasized.

C. Define what it means to live with your wife in an understanding way. What is the command and warning of I Peter 3:7?

The outline for the women should include the following:

A. How is the wife to be a helper to her husband?

B. A submissive wife as defined by Scripture. There will be many passages studied in chapter 16 of “Preparing for Your Marriage.” The project pages of this chapter will play a key role.

C. Home is where the heart is!

Read I Corinthians 8-10 and Romans 14. Then consider asking the following questions.

IV. Meeting 4 – Before Your Marriage.

This meeting will cover chapters 18-21 of “Preparing for Your Marriage.”

Read I Corinthians 7: 1-7, and study I Thessalonians 4: 1-8 and be prepared to discuss how a sexual relationship in a Christian marriage differs from a pagan one.

Complete a Budget.

A. Become familiar with Scripture as it relates to solving problems and conflicts.

B. Thoroughly review the Book of Proverbs and encourage the couple to heed the counsel found there.

C. Study of I Thessalonians 4: 1-8 for the homework assignment.

D. Preparation of a budget for the homework assignment.

V. Meeting 5 – Your Wedding and After.

This meeting will cover chapters 22 – 26 of “Preparing for Your Marriage.”

Bible texts dealing with vows: Numbers 30:2; Deuteronomy 23:21-23; Judges 11:29-40; Psalms 15:4; 76:11; Proverbs 20:25; Ecclesiastes 5:4-5.

Bible In One Year

Dear Couple,

We are excited that God has allowed for you to be apart of this wonderful journey leading to the road of matrimony.

As you enter this new season in your life, we have embarked upon the goal of reading the entire Bible in a year. What an awesome chance to hear God speak to us directly through His Word. We invite you to join us in this spiritual endeavor. We have provided some tips to aid you with your daily reading.

First, **Schedule your Bible study time.** Set aside a specific amount of time to read and study your Bible each day. As you read through the study guide, some days may require more time and than others. If you don't put study into your daily schedule, you will never make time for it. You should study your Bible when you are at your best physically, emotionally, intellectually and when you are can be undistracted and unhurried.

Second, **Keep a notebook or journal.** As you begin to read and study the Bible, God will reveal things to you through His Word. Keeping a notebook or journal will allow you to reflect back on the things you have learned, experienced and observed.

Third, **Get the right tools.** As you read, there may be words, phrases, etc. that you do not fully understand. There are excellent reference books and website available to you. There are different translations of the Bible, such as New International Version, The Amplified Bible or The New American Standard Bible. A concordance is a Bible index of words and references where they word may be found. A Bible dictionary or encyclopedia explains words, topics, customs and traditions in the Bible as well as gives historical, geographic and cultural information. A commentary is a scholarly collection of explanatory notes and interpretations on the text of a particular Bible book or section. Commentaries explain and interpret the meaning of the biblical message by analyzing the words used, background, introduction, grammar and syntax, and

relation of that particular book to the rest of the Bible. Useful websites include bible.com, blueletterbible.com and crosswalk.com.

Finally, **Spend a short time in prayer before each study.** Ask the Lord to cleanse your life from all sin and to fill you with the Holy Spirit, so you will be in fellowship with Him during this study. Ask the Lord to guide you in your study. The best way to understand the Bible is to talk with its Author. Memorize Psalm 119:18 and use it before each study: “Open thou mine eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of thy law.”

In this series, you will find that each day contains a passage from the Old Testament, the New Testament, Psalms, and Proverbs. There is also a space for you to record your thoughts, observations or revelations. We encourage you to print the monthly scriptures and store them in a three-ring binder. This will allow you to stay on track each month. Finally, remember that when you are reading the Bible, you are not just reading some stories, you are reading God's Word . . .

God is speaking to you!
